Position Summary

The RN will support patient care and the delivery of FHT programs working collaboratively within an inter professional healthcare team. The RN will practice within the full scope of practice as outlined in the Standards of Practice by the College of Nurses of Ontario.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Individual patient assessment patient history, recording of vitals, biometric measurements, triage of clients based on acuity of problems
- Coordinate appropriate diagnostic tests and procedures in consultation with family physicians or in accordance with medical directives. This includes performing Well Women Exams, monitoring anticoagulation therapy, STI screening and other acute medical treatments.
- Implement various goal-oriented, time-limited intervention plans, including education in collaboration with patient and/or family and inter-disciplinary team.
- Apply self-management and other strategies to support the development of an informed activated patient.
- Help facilitate the incorporation of proven strategies for individual family physician practices to provide more effective care delivery.
- Participate as a clinical team member in the development and delivery of targeted programs including but not limited to chronic disease management, child and family health, illness prevention and screening
- Provide timely and informative reports as directed and requested by the Executive Director and/or Physician Lead.
- Actively participate in staff meetings, to exchange ideas, receive mutual support and monitor program outcomes as well as present case studies.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- A Bachelor's of Science in Nursing
- Current registration and member in good standing with the College of Nurses of Ontario as a Registered Nurse
- Current Membership with RNAO
- Community nursing experience with focus on well baby and well woman health. Well Women Exam certification is an asset.
- Knowledge and a demonstrated nursing ability in community health, public health sciences, and chronic disease management.
- Demonstrated skills in assessment, program planning, implementation and evaluation.
- Work effectively, both independently and as part of an interprofessional team.
- Flexibility and ability to adapt to change.
- Ability to utilize an electronic documentation of health records
- Available to work some evening
